



INSTRUCTIONS

20' Self Set Tents

PARTS LIST:

	20X20	20X30
SIDE POLE (2 piece)	8	10
CENTER POLE (3 piece)	1	2
STAKES	12	14
BAG WITH TOP	1	1
BAG FOR POLES	1	1

MANPOWER REQUIRED: Two (2) installers should be able to assemble a Self Set Tent in approximately thirty (30) minutes.

TOOLS REQUIRED: Sledge Hammer

INSPECT SITE CAUTION: Please consult your local utility company prior to installation. Prior to assembly be sure to look around the area for obstacles, pipes, wires, etc.

LAYOUT AND CHECK: Use the parts list for a quick identification and check list for the proper quantities.

1. Layout at Site:

Spread out drop cloths and unroll canopy top at exact position of desired finished assembly. Any sharp objects which must remain on site under the canopy should be padded and taped. Assemble side poles and lay straight out from each pole hole in the canopy. Drive a stake 1'-0" from the end of each pole. The stake must be driven through the ring attached to each guy rope.

2. Raise Side Poles:

Start at the opposite corners. Insert side poles into the pole holes and rise so that the bottom of the poles slants toward the center of the canopy. Adjust the guy rope. Continue with other two (2) corners and then sides.

3. Raise Center Pole:

Assemble three (3) piece center poles and insert into the center pole hole. Rise to upright position and tie off jump rope to the pole.

4. Side Pole Adjustment:

Tighten the guy ropes and then set the side poles to the upright position. Adjust the positions and guy rope tensions to the properly pull out canopy. Protective covers are recommended to all the stakes.

5. Take Down:

Loosen all the guy ropes. Spread the drop cloths. Reverse steps 1 through 4 for disassembly.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Check Guy Ropes periodically for tightness and maintaining of good condition. Stakes provided are for average soil conditions. Sandy soil or asphalt may require additional staking. Proper installation suitable to site conditions is the responsibility of the Installer. Store canopy in a cool, dry area. Never store while wet or damp.
